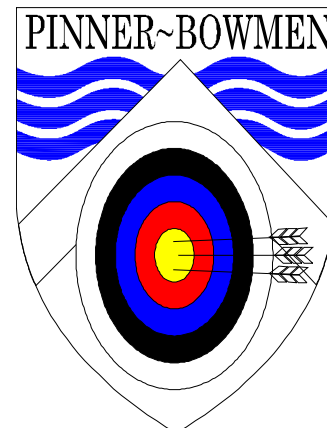


# PINNER BOWMEN

## NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS



### Club Shooting Rules & Regulations

No arrow is to be shot in any manner other than appropriate for the distance. Under no circumstance should any arrow be loosed unless it is specifically aimed at a target boss.

Failure to observe this rule will result in the archer concerned being barred immediately from further shooting (if a guest) or **EXPULSION FROM PINNER BOWMEN**, without further notice or appeal or recompense of any fees paid, if so voted by a simple majority of the committee.

All shooting will cease if so ordered by the Field Captain or Safety Officer or a Committee member.

No shooting is to take place unless three club members are present and a Field Captain is designated and present on the shooting line.

The shooting of compound bows and cross bows is not permitted without the specific permission of the Committee.
